<u>Score Form</u> – Identifies the grading criteria that a candidate will be graded on at an identified level. Also, the answer sheet that is used to evaluate a candidate on Hazardous Materials Awareness is available to be printed off.

Skill Sheets – Identifies the skills sheets to evaluate a candidate on an identified level being evaluated along with the objectives needing to be accomplished.

<u>Taskbook</u> – skills that will need to be completed prior to skills test date. Candidates should bring a completed taskbook on initial skills test date.

**Reciprocity** – Form used for individuals that hold certification from ISAC or Pro Board. Basically, it used to transfer the information onto our database, if we hold that level of certification. An individual that is requesting reciprocity from an ISAC certification a Pro Board application will be issued. However, if an individual is requesting reciprocity from a Pro Board certification, the individual will not receive another Pro Board application. The information will only be transferred onto our database, because they already hold a Pro Board certification for that identified level.
