INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATE

The information listed below will help in your preparation for the written test for Aircraft Rescue Fire Fighter.

PREREQUISITE TO CHALLENGE TEST

State Certification Test Prerequisite

1. Individuals who have had continuous service, dated before October 2005 as Aircraft Rescue Firefighters, must be trained to the level of FDC 101 Basic Firefighter equaling 120 hours.

OR

Individuals who have been assigned as Aircraft Rescue Firefighters as of October 2005 must be trained to the level of NPQ Firefighter I

2. Completed the most current edition of the State of Georgia Basic Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting Course and each student has completed each objective specified in the curriculum.

3. Completed the live fire training portions:

- Interior aircraft fires
- Engine and APU/EPU fires
- Pooled fuel fires
- 3D fuel fires (running fuel fire)
- Wheel assembly fire

4. Completed the performance standards of NFPA 1003 "Standard for Airport Firefighter Professional Qualifications."

5. Has met the applicable Federal Aviation Administration performance standards.

6. Has completed all requirements as specified in OCGA 25-4-31.
