PREREQUISITE TO CHALLENGE TEST

1. Completed a training program that meets or exceeds all requirements of NFPA 1031 "Standard for Professional Qualifications for Fire Inspector and Plan Examiner" Fire Inspector I.
2. Completed a Hazardous Materials Course that meets or exceeds all objectives of NFPA 472 "Standard for Professional Competence of Responders to Hazardous Materials incidents" First Responder Awareness Level, written and skills examination.
3. Completed a training program that meets or exceeds the "Introduction to Fire Inspection Principals and Practices."

WRITTEN TEST MATERIALS

2. IFSTA, Essentials of Firefighting 4th edition.
3. Delmar, Firefighters Handbook 1st edition.

SKILLS TEST MATERIALS

1. Six (6) scenarios. Fifty (50) fill in the blank questions. Using NFPA 101 "Life Safety Code Handbook". Timed test five (5) hours.

STATE CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Pass a 140 multiple choice question written test with a pass rate of 70%.
2. Complete a Fire Inspector certification package.

PRO BOARD CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Pass a 140 multiple choice question written test with a 70% pass rate.
2. Pass a skills test consisting of using the NFPA 101 "Life Safety Code". Fifty (50) fill in the blank questions.
3. National certification will only be awarded to candidates that have successfully completed both written and skills examinations.
