



## GEORGIA FIREFIGHTER STANDARDS AND TRAINING COUNCIL MODULE 1 Live Fire Course



In order to become a Registered Volunteer Firefighter, anyone appointed on or after July 1, 2005, must successfully complete “Module 1” of the State of Georgia Basic Firefighter NPQ-1 Course.

For credit from the Georgia Firefighter Standards and Training Council, the live fire component must meet the following conditions:

- The live-fire component shall be taught by the Georgia Fire Academy **or** by instructors who have completed an apprenticeship as a live-fire instructor with the Georgia Fire Academy.
- The live-fire component must be instructed in accordance with NFPA 1403 “Standard on Live Fire Training Evolutions” and applicable EPD regulations. The Module 1 component must be completed prior to the live fire evolution.

**REMEMBER:**

- Each participant of the live-fire component must be at least eighteen (18) years of age.
- Each participant must be a representative of a compliant fire department or approved agency.
- All participants must have protective coats, trousers, hoods, footwear, helmets, and gloves manufactured to the requirements of NFPA 1971 “Standard on Protective Ensembles for Structural Fire Fighting and Proximity Fire Fighting.
- SCBA shall have been manufactured to meet the requirements of NFPA 1981 ‘Standard on Open-Circuit Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) for Fire and Emergency Services.
- Available water supply must meet requirements of NFPA 1142 “Standard on Water Supplies for Suburban and Rural Fire Fighting”.
