## ATTACK TEAM

- ◆ 1. Establishes crew integrity & ensures members are wearing full PPE.
- ◆ 2. Selects appropriate attack techniques for the given level of the fire (attic, grade level, upper levels, basement).
- ◆ 3. Communicates attack techniques to the attack teams.
- ◆ 4. Maintains constant team coordination.
- ◆ 5. Continuously evaluates fire growth and development.
- ◆ 6. Communicates or manages fire attack requirements.
- ◆ 7. Reports hazards to other teams.
- ◆ 8. Apprises the incident commander of changing conditions.

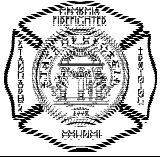

- ◆ 4. Maintains constant team coordination.
- ◆ 5. Continuously evaluates fire growth and development.
- ◆ 6. Communicates or manages ventilation requirements.
- ◆ 7. Reports hazards to attack teams.
- ◆ 8. Apprises the incident commander of changing conditions.

- ◆ 7. Reports hazards to attack teams.
- ◆ 8. Apprises the incident commander of changing conditions.
