INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATE

The information listed below will help in your preparation for the written and skills test for Wildland Firefighter I.

PREREQUISITE TO CHALLENGE TEST

- 1. Completed training as specified in the National Wildland Fire Coordinating Group Course NWCG 130 "Introduction to Fire Behavior". (This course addresses the foundational skills universal to all Wildland firefighters).
- 2. Completed training as specified in the National Wildland Fire Coordinating Group Course NWCG 190 "Firefighter Training". (This course covers the basic concepts of Wildland fire behavior, fuels, weather and topography).
- 3. Completed training as specified in the National Wildland Fire Coordinating Group Course NWCG "ICS Orientation" (8 hour self study).
- 4. Completed each objective in NFPA 1051 "Standard for Wildland Firefighter Professional Qualifications" Wildland Firefighter I.
- 5. Posses or have immediate access to Personal Protective Equipment specifically for Wildland Firefighting as specified in NFPA 1977 "Standard on Protective Clothing and Equipment for Wildland Firefighting."
- 6. Maintaining physical fitness is a critical component of being an effective wild-land firefighter. Prior to taking the S130 field exercise, students must satisfactorily complete the Work Capacity Test or physical fitness test as required.
